("AGREEMENT")**

In consideration of participating in Airsoft Games and Events hosted by **Alan Muller t/a U-TAC Urban Tactical**, I the undersigned declare that I understand the nature of this activity and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity. I acknowledge that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the activity and inform **Alan Muller t/a U-TAC Urban Tactical** of my concern. I fully understand that this activity involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and even death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the "Releasees" named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, cost and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the activity.

I hereby release, discharge, and undertake not to hold liable **Alan Muller t/a U-TAC Urban Tactical**, its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, and sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the activity takes place, (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages, on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost, which any may incur as the result of such claim.

U-TAC Urban Tactical Field Rules:-

General Rules

- Airsoft is a Fun sport and should be played in that manner:- any overly aggressive behavior, "hot" markers, temper tantrums and anti social actions will not be tolerated.
- The Marshals word is Final.
- Honor and integrity are part of the game, any form of cheating will be exposed by Marshals and published.
- No players will be allowed to play if thought to be under the influence of any illegal substances and or alcohol. Consumption of alcohol will only be allowed when government legislation allows for alcohol to be consumed. No alcohol may be brought onto the premises until such time as it is legal to do so. No Exceptions.
- No current or old SADF, SAPS or SANDF clothing may be worn. The old South African Flag is not permitted to be worn or displayed.
- No racial or sexual discrimination will be tolerated.
- All AEG GBB or Scenario devices must be in bags/closed container when arriving at field until in Safe Area.
- Firearms, knives (unless tool set), pepper spray, tear gas, batons, bayonets/swords not permitted on the playing field or safe/rest area.
- Unless in play no markers may be pointed at another person even if secure with barrel blocker.
- All players need to understand that airsoft is strenuous and extremely physically active, the terrain is rough and unpredictable, thus if players have any medical and or mental condition or believe they might have; they should reconsider playing.
- We are playing in Nature and natural activities, respect and be aware of plants and animals some might bite. Do not modify or break down barriers and or bunkers.

General Play Rules (excluding game mechanics)

- All AEG GBB AEP Spring Action (guns) need to have an approved plug or a barrel sock.
- Barrel Socks or plugs must be used in the safe area at all times, they should also be used on the playing area until a marshal allows the removal of them. These blockers must be re attached before leaving the playing field. Eye Protection must be worn at all times during play, They must be put on before entering the field of play. Masks are highly recommended due to the CQB nature of U-Tac.
- All devices must be chronographed before play. If deemed necessary marshals may add additional chrono requirements. All AEG, GBB, spring action must Chrono at 1,49 Jules or less with a 0,3g BB (Maximum BB weight allowed is 0.3g) Hand Guns/ pistols need to chrono at 1J or less with a 0,20g BB (Maximum BB weight allowed is 0,2g) players wishing to use specialised role devices with dedicated Jule ratings need to enquire and follow a full accreditation protocol if and when this is available.
- Only approved plastic bbs may be used, no metal, glass, ceramic or pepper balls etc.
- Do not climb trees or jump into rivers or holes.
- All custom and home built weaponry/modifications need to be approved by the Head Marshal.
- No pyrotechnical devices may be used unless provided by or approved by U-Tac
- Players may only play in the designated and demarcated playing areas.
- A Minimum Engagement Distance (MED) of 5m applies to AEGs and 3m to pistols,.
- Unnecessary over shooting will not be tolerated.
- Breaking of any of the above rules may lead to you being sent off the field, asked to leave the premises, barred from current and future play. Note bad behavior reports will be shared with other fields.

Additional :- Covid 19 Lockdown requirements.

- All Covid protocols as laid out by Field and Head Marshal to be strictly adhered to.
- All players will be required to fill in a Covid questionnaire and send it via email to U-tac before attending, atleast 48 hours prior to event.
- All players need to send through proof of SANPA membership with every booking.
- There will be no payment on the day, all payments must be done before hand (at least 48 hours prior) This will secure your place in the game.

Procedure:- Event/training/tournament will be advertised with available slots

Interested athletes wishing to participate should join the relevant whats app group.

Only once; completed indemnity, covid questionnaire, SANPA membership and payment have been received will your slot be secured, First Come First served.

The relevant whats app group will keep track of remaining slots etc.

- If you are car pooling please ensure you make note of with whom you are traveling.
- A cloth mask or buff must be worn at all times except during play, an airsoft facemask will be considered sufficient for during play.
- Transition from Cloth Mask to airsoft mask (or both) can only take place after Chrono is completed.
- Your temperature will be taken while you are still in your car as you reach the parking area entrance.
- You will be allocated a parking spot, you will need to remain in that area until as such a time as you go to chrono
- You will kit up at your car
- You will not enter anyone elses Parking Spot
- You will be ready to play before you get to chrono as once you have chronoed there is not returning to the safe area until the end of the game.
- Please make use of the Multiple Sanitation stations on a regular basis during your visit.
- There will be very specific rules and procedures for chrono, you will be explained before hand as to how the procedure will work, but should you be unsure there will be Marshals/players to assist you.
- Once you have stepped onto the field you will wait in the holding area until the game starts, please ensure social distancing while waiting.
- There will not be medic rules at this time, respawn points and methods will be designated before the game.
- Any additional safety precautions may be issued from time to time, please ensure you abide by them.
